RETRACTED: Abdi et al. Duloxetine, an SNRI, Targets pSTAT3 Signaling: *In-Silico*, RNA-Seq and *In-Vitro* Evidence for a Pleiotropic Mechanism of Pain Relief. *Int. J. Mol. Sci.* 2025, 26, 10432

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The journal retracts the article titled “Duloxetine, an SNRI, Targets pSTAT3 Signaling: *In-Silico*, RNA-Seq and *In-Vitro* Evidence for a Pleiotropic Mechanism of Pain Relief” [1], cited above.

Following publication, concerns were brought to the attention of the Editorial Office regarding data and scientific issues in this publication [1].

In accordance with standard journal procedures, the Editorial Office and Editorial Board conducted an investigation that confirmed inconsistencies in the molecular docking simulations and identified several methodological limitations in this article [1]. Although the authors collaborated with the investigation and shared supporting materials, the Editorial Board concluded that the evidence presented was insufficient to support the article’s overall findings and conclusions. As a result, the Editorial Board has decided to retract this paper as per MDPI’s retraction policy.

This retraction was approved by the Editor-in-Chief of the journal *IJMS*.

The authors have been informed of this retraction and have indicated their disagreement with this decision.
